

Olympic Hoop Game Craft

Here's a fun way to make an Olympic hoop game!

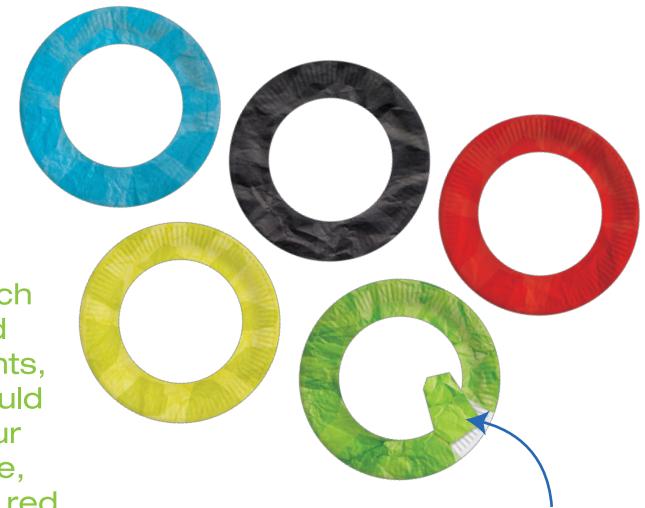
You will need:

Six white paper plates, tape, pencil, scissors, blue, black, red, yellow and green tissue paper (or paints, pens or pencils), kitchen roll tube.

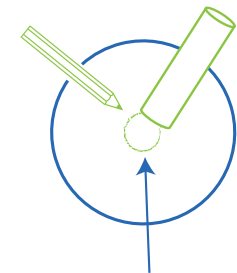


Instructions

- 1 Cut the middle out of 5 paper plates to make the hoops.
- 2 Decorate the front of each plate hoop with coloured tissue paper (or use paints, pens or pencils). You could make one for each colour of the Olympic rings: blue, yellow, black, green and red.
- 3 Place the end of the kitchen roll tube in the middle of the last paper plate. Draw around it. Cut out the circle.
- 4 Decorate the BACK of the plate however you like, making sure not to cover the hole. We used orange tissue paper and the decorations on the last page.



Cover with tissue paper.



Draw around the tube, then cut out the circle

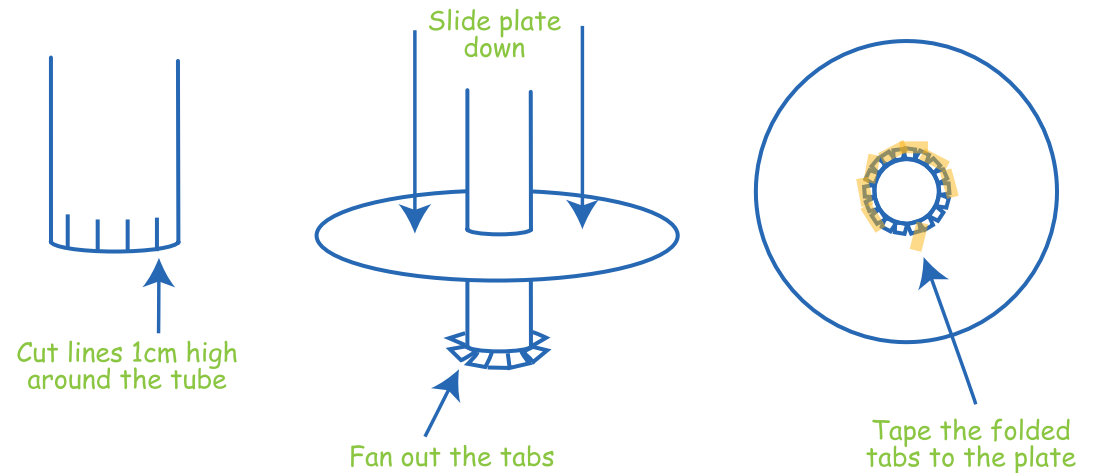
Decorate however you like!



Please remember to recycle this activity

- 5 Cut 1cm lines all around the end of the kitchen roll tube.
- 6 With the plate front side down, slide the plate down the tube. Fold the tabs out, then turn the plate up the other way and tape the tabs to the plate.

You now have a fantastic

The Game!

You are now ready to play the Olympic hoop game!

See if you can throw the hoops over the tube in the order of the Olympic rings. Blue first, then black, red, yellow, green last.

Stand a good distance away from the target so it's not too easy.

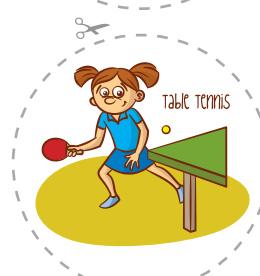
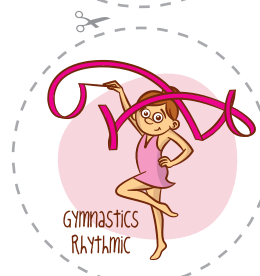
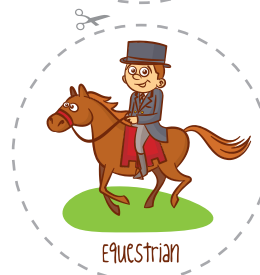
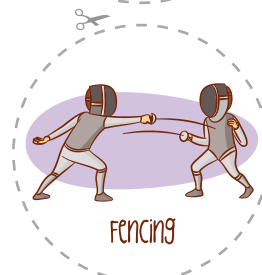
Give points for each colour: 5 points for blue, 10 for black, 15 for red, 20 for yellow and 25 for green.

Each person gets 2 goes to try and get it over the tube.

Whoever has the most points at the end of the game is the winner!!
