

Make a Poppy

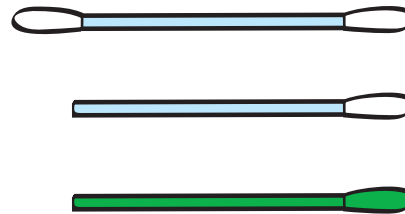


You will need

Red tissue paper
Black tissue paper
Scissors
Cotton bud
Green acrylic paint
Tape

Instructions

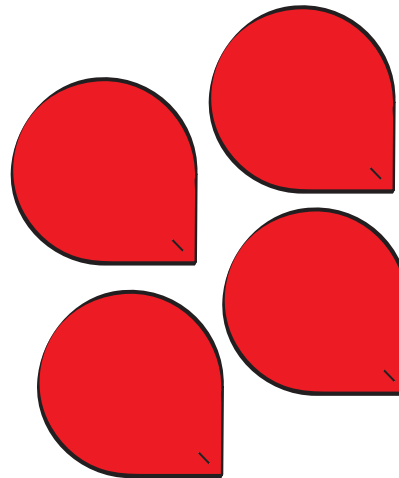
①



Take the cotton wool off one end of the cotton bud stick. (You may need to get an adult to help you).

Paint the cotton bud green and leave to dry.

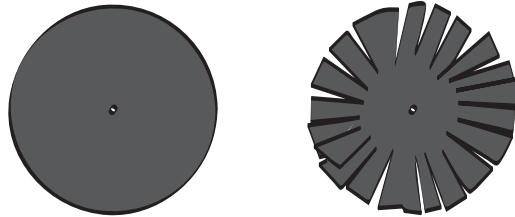


Using the template on the last page, cut out **four** red petals making a small hole at the end of each petal.



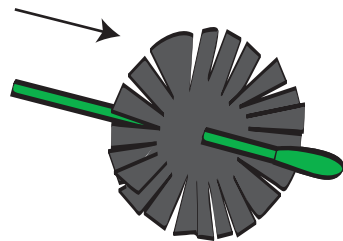

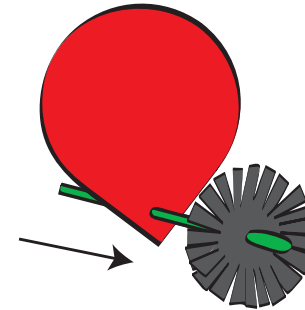
Using the template on the last page cut out **one** black circle with a small hole in the middle. Cut around the edge of the circle to make a fringe effect.

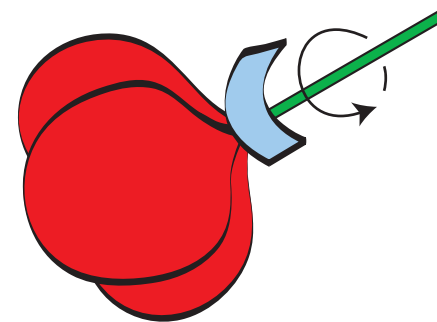
Put the stick end of the painted cotton bud through the hole in the black circle. Push it up to the end.

Next, put the cotton bud stick through the hole in the petal. Push the petal up to the end. Repeat this for all the petals. Arrange the petals to make a flower shape.

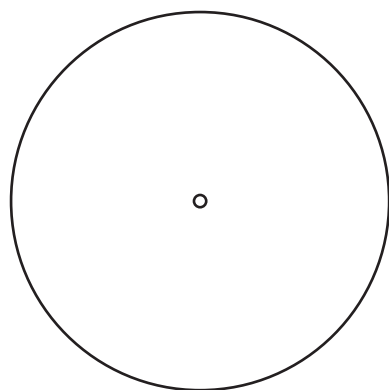


Place tape at the base of the petals around the stick to hold it all in place.

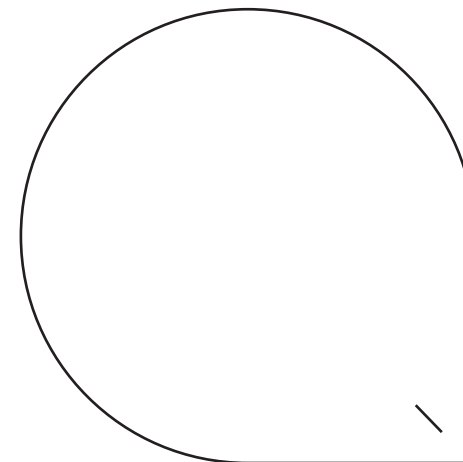
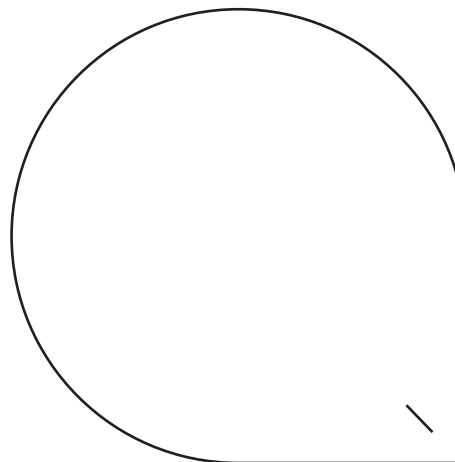
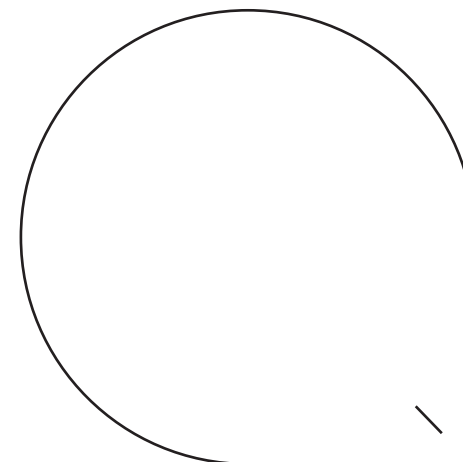
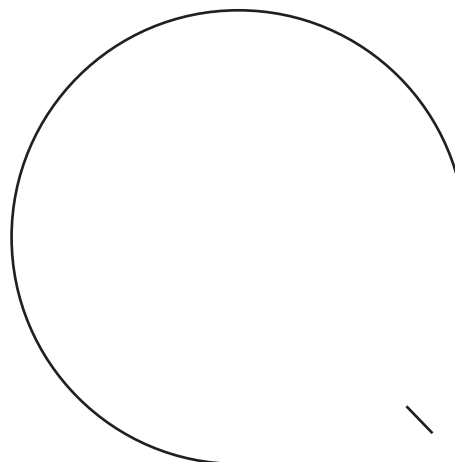
You now have a beautiful poppy!
