Science Key Stage 2 Year 5	Curriculum Link: • describe the movement of the Earth, and other planets, relative to the Sun in the solar system For this lesson, the children are to research one of the planets in the solar system, either for homework or during the lesson. They can then give a presentation to the class, during this lesson or a subsequent lesson. You can begin by asking the children the names of all the planets in our solar system. The mnemonic can be a prompt: My Very Excellent Mother Just Served Us Noodles.
