



# OUT IN ALL WEATHERS WITH PEPPA

**AGE RANGE** Early Years/Key Stage 1

**TIME** 20–30 minutes

**CURRICULUM LINKS** Understanding the World (PSHE, Science and Geography), Mathematics, Communication and Language, Literacy, (English), Personal, Social and Emotional Development, (PSHE), Physical Development (PE).

## FURTHER INFORMATION

Peppa Pig is an extremely popular character with young children. A lovable, cheeky pig, she lives with her brother George and the rest of her family. She really enjoys dressing up, playing outside and splashing about in muddy puddles. The show first started in 2004 and to celebrate their ten year anniversary, Peppa will be wearing special golden boots.

## ACTIVITY

### You will need

Pencils, crayons or water based felt tip pens, safety scissors, sticky tape, glue or blue tak.

### Instructions

1. Using the weather chart provided, cut out weather symbols and help Peppa Pig fill in the chart over a period of one week. If you don't want to use the cut out symbols then ask the children to draw a symbol to show the weather that day.
2. The chart also has a section for the temperature: hot, cold, warm, chilly. Older children might also like to write in a description of the weather at the end or some weather words for that particular day e.g. cold, cloudy, breezy.

### FURTHER IDEAS

- Talk to the children about Peppa Pig. What kind of clothes will she need to wear if she goes out to post a letter: in the rain, the hot sun, the snow, or fog?
- Make up a special Peppa Pig dance to go with each type of weather. A rainy or a sunny dance. How would they differ?
- Older children could discuss the kind of games Peppa Pig likes to play with her friends. Make up a new game she could play. They could try this out with their friends.
- Talk about the kind of clothes Peppa might wear for different events, such as a party, Christmas day, a visit to see the Queen, going swimming, going to school. What would the children wear for similar events?
- Write a story or poem about a day when Peppa Pig gets caught in the rain.
