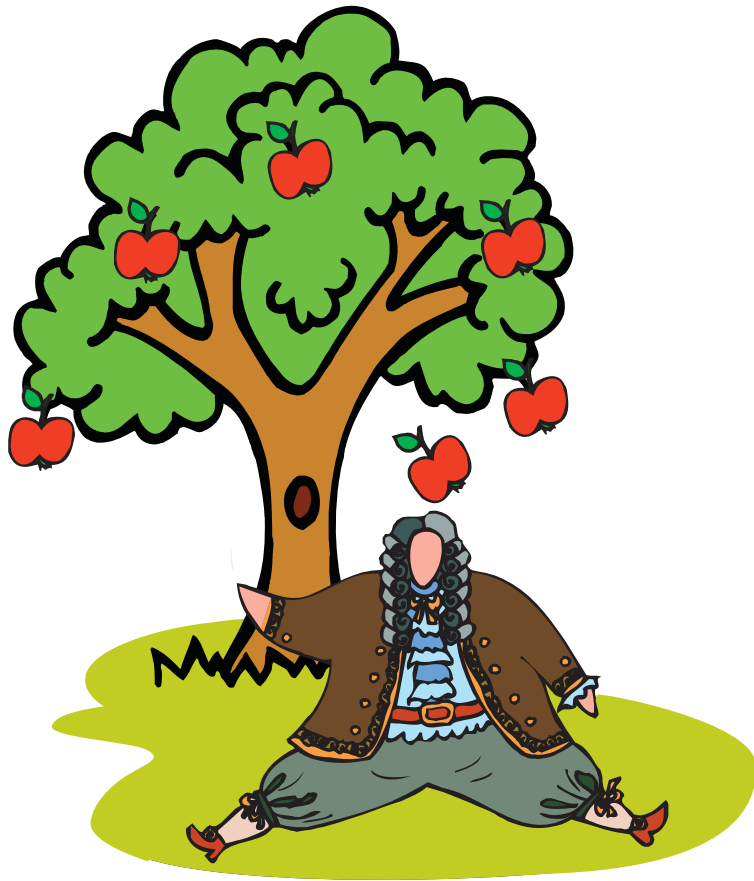
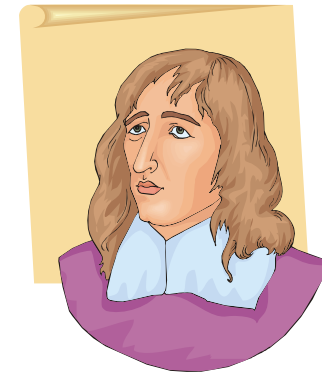


Sir Isaac Newton
