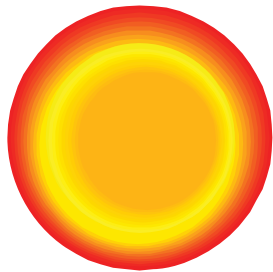


Temperatures

Temperature is a measure of how hot or cold something is.

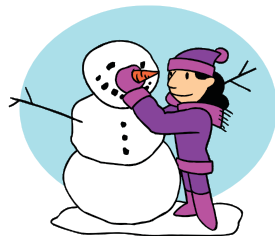

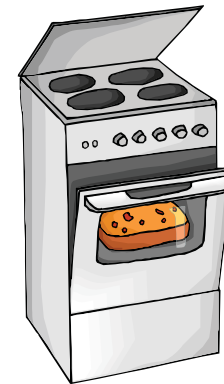
