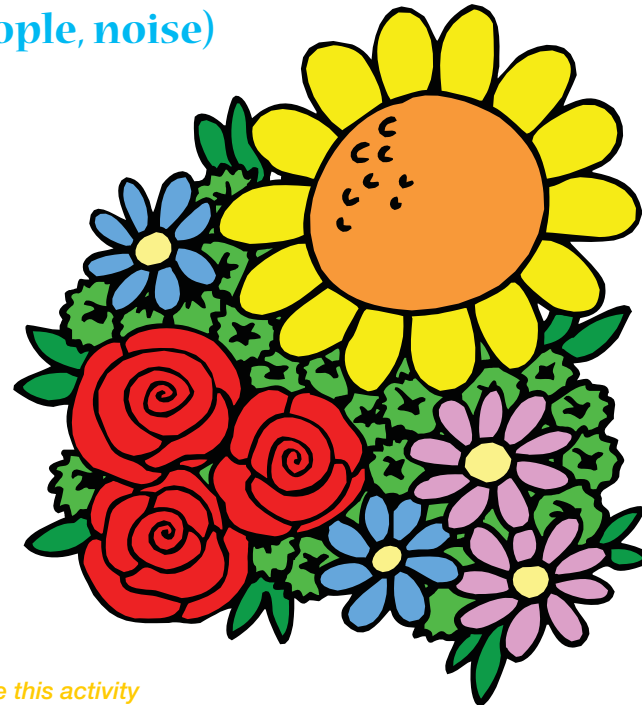


Making a family

Underline the correct word in each bracket.

Most flowers produce (**seeds**, **animals**, **children**). It is from these seeds that new plants grow. They usually need (**water**, **salt**, **pollen**) from another plant of the same type to produce seeds. Pollen is carried by the (**school**, **wind**, **walls**) or by insects. Insects are attracted to the (**flowers**, **people**, **noise**) by the bright colours. They are looking for (**nectar**, **birds**, **animals**) a sugary liquid. As they collect this their (**noses**, **bodies**, **arms**) pick up pollen which is like a powder. When they go to the next (**flower**, **insect**, **book**) some of the pollen can brush off and may (**stain**, **fertilize**, **hurt**) the flower so that (**babies**, **caterpillars**, **seeds**) can be produced.
