

Paper Plate Chick

Here's a fun way to make a Chick.



You will need:

2 White paper plates, yellow paint. You can even use tissue paper if you like. Scissors, glue, yellow feathers, and Orange card.

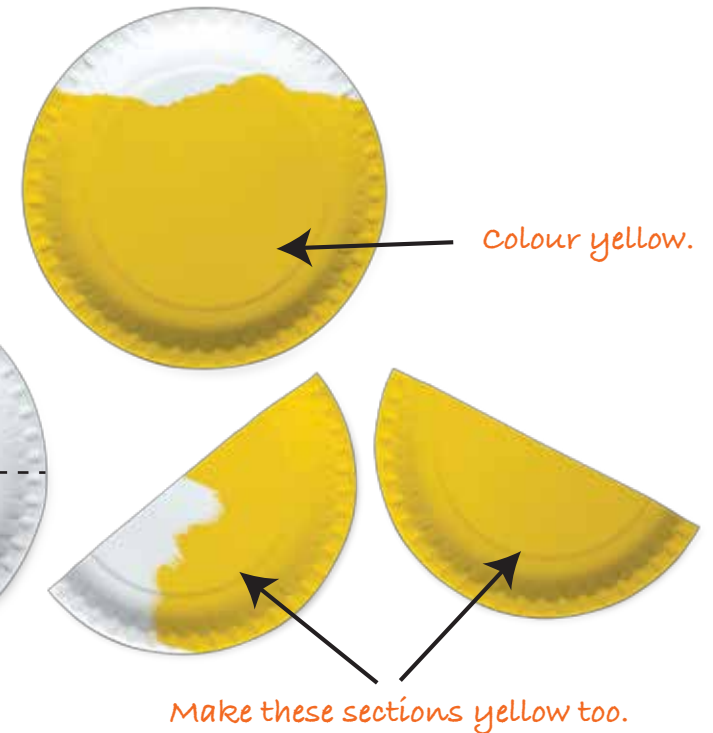
Instructions

1 Cut one of your paper plates in half to make the wings. The whole plate will become the body.

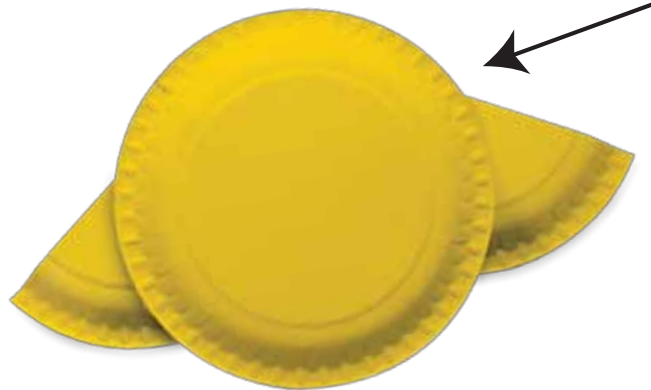
2 Colour in the plate and the two halves yellow, you could even paint with your fingers. Alternatively, you can scrunch up little bits of yellow tissue paper and stick them all over the body and wings. Be as creative as you like!

3 Stick the wings behind the plate as shown above. Next, cut out a square of orange card. (About 3cm by 3cm). Fold it in half to create the beak. Glue on to your Chick. (Alternatively, you can use the orange squares on this page. Simply cut them out and stick the 2 squares together so it's orange both sides. Fold as above.)

4 Next, cut out the eyes and feet on this page. Glue them on to your Chick.

5 For the finishing touch glue some feathers to the top of the plate.
