

Make a Sun Visor

Here's a fun way to make a sun visor.

You will need:

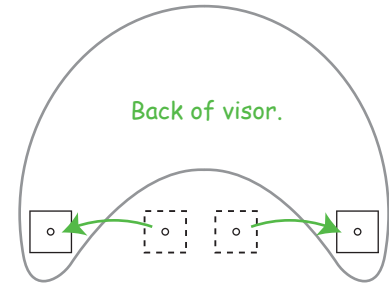
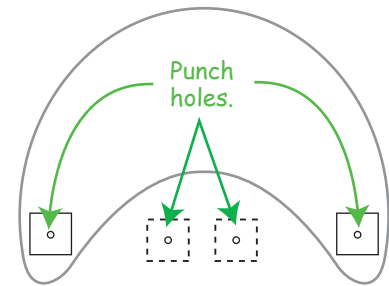
Card to print on, Elastic, Colouring in Pens or Pencils, Glue, Scissors, and a Hole Punch.



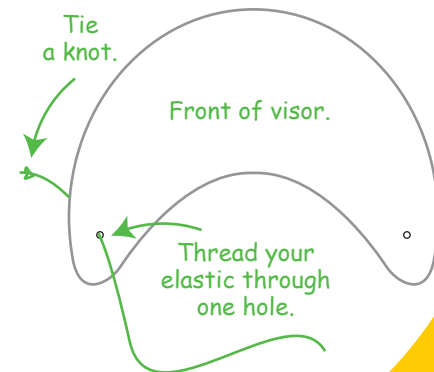
Instructions

- 1 Print out the visor template on the next page onto card, then cut it out.
- 2 Punch holes at each end of your visor shape where shown. Reinforce the holes by cutting the small square templates from the spare bit of card. Next, punch a hole in them and then glue them on the back side of the visor over the holes you've already punched out. (See example).
- 3 You can now decorate your visor however you like!
- 4 Cut a piece of elastic long enough to go around the back of your head. Tie one end of the piece of elastic in one hole. Next, adjust the elastic on the visor to fit around your head by threading it through the other hole, then tying a knot. (You may want an adult to help you here because it's a bit fiddly to do on your own).

You now have a fantastic
Sun Visor!

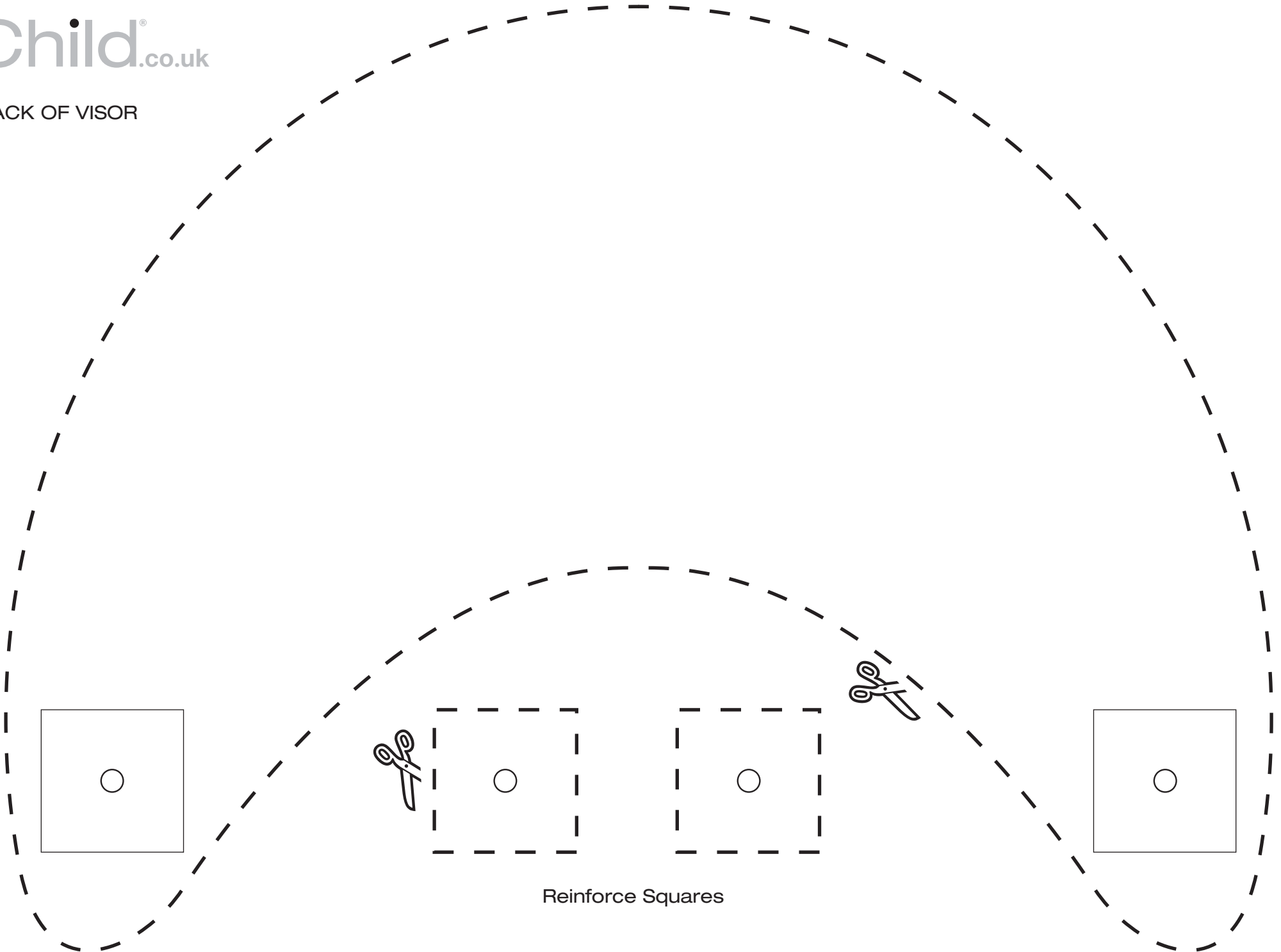


Reinforce the holes by cutting the small square templates out and sticking them on the back of your visor where shown.
