

Heart Mobile Craft

Here's a fun way to make a heart mobile.

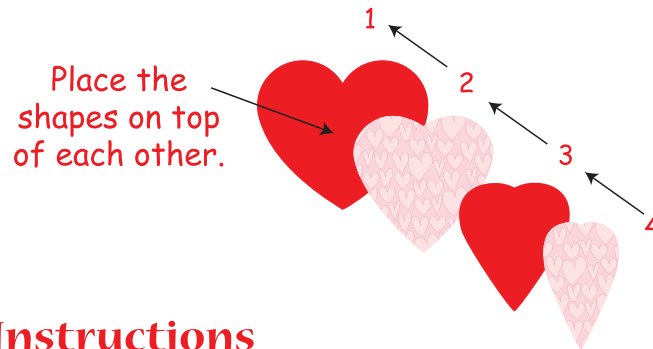


You will need

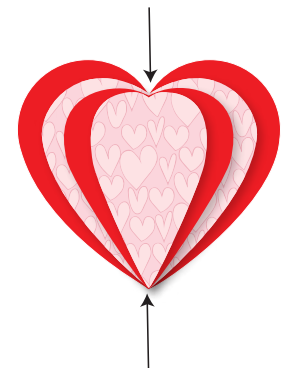
A4 printer paper, coat hanger, scissors, stapler, thread, glue and tape.

Optional

Colouring pens or pencils (red and pink are best).



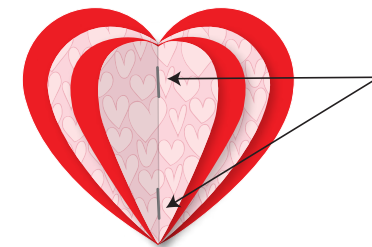
Centre them by lining up the heart shapes top and bottom.



Instructions

- 1 Print the coloured heart shapes on pages 3, 4, 5, 6 and 7. One page makes one heart. Or print 5 copies of the black and white heart shapes on page 8.
- 2 Make one heart at a time by cutting out all the coloured heart shapes on page 3 (or black and white on page 8). Next place them together so that the point and the dip are lined up. Start with shape number 1, then number 2, and so on, ie biggest to smallest shape.
- 3 Fold the pile of hearts in half. Then carefully unfold them again. Put two staples along the center fold to hold them in place, then fan the shapes out. Do this for all the pages. You will then have 5 hearts. (You can make more if you like).

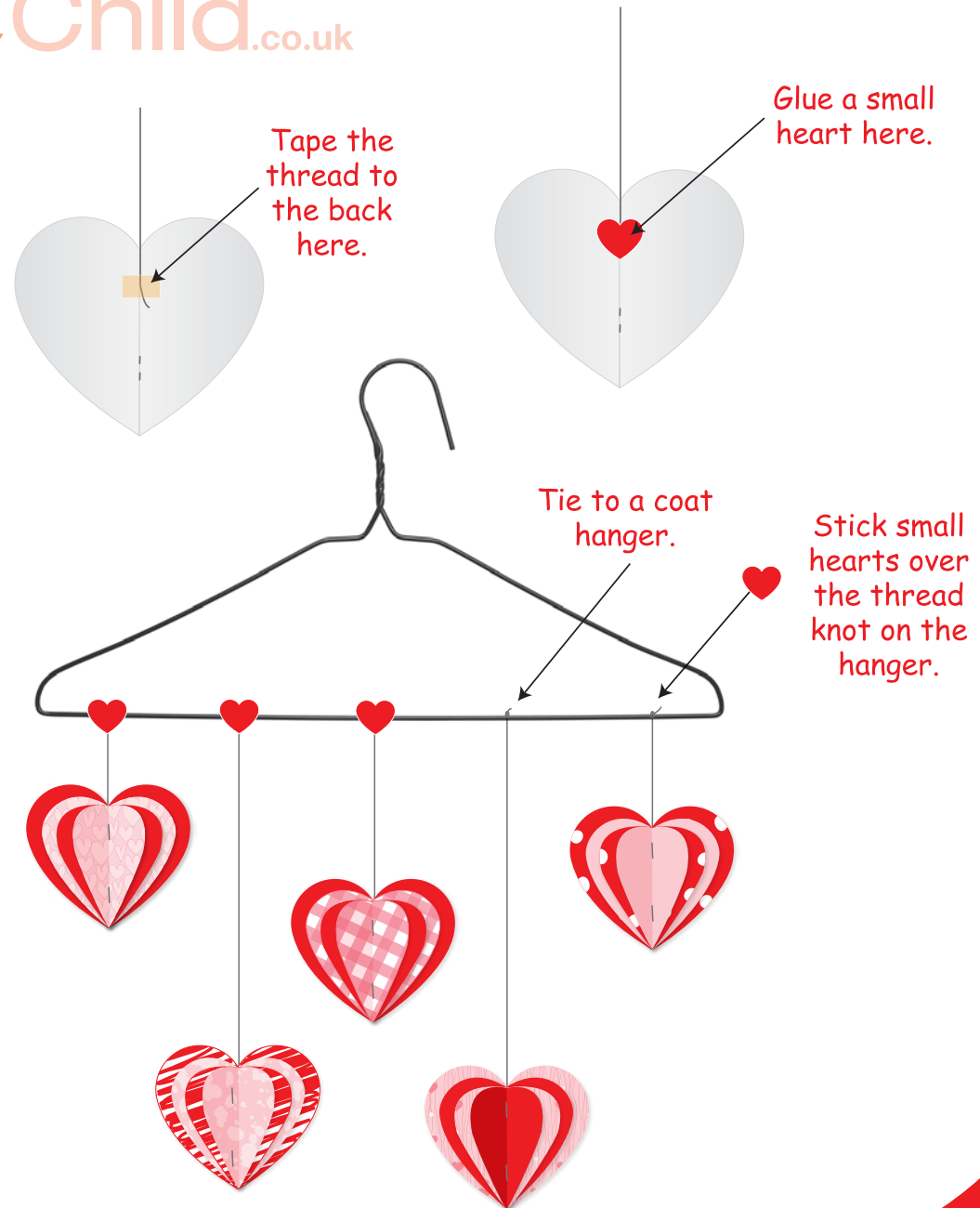
Fold the pile of hearts in half.



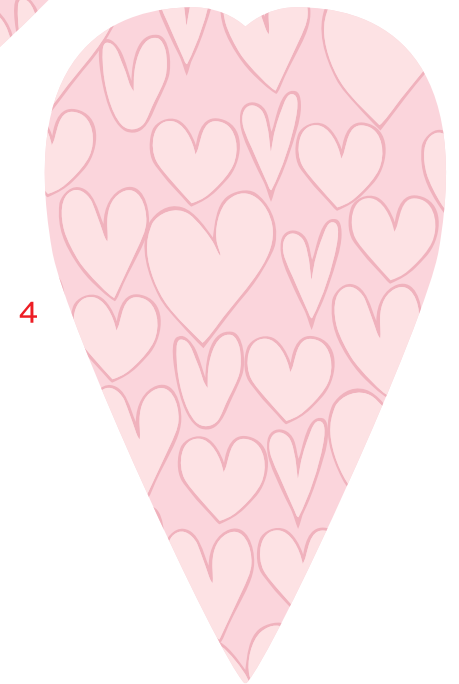
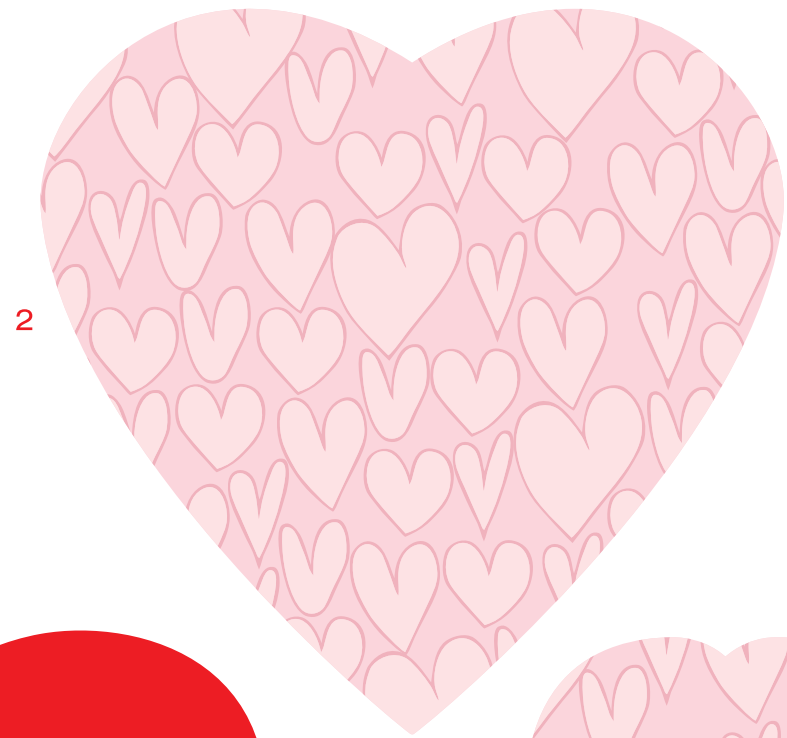

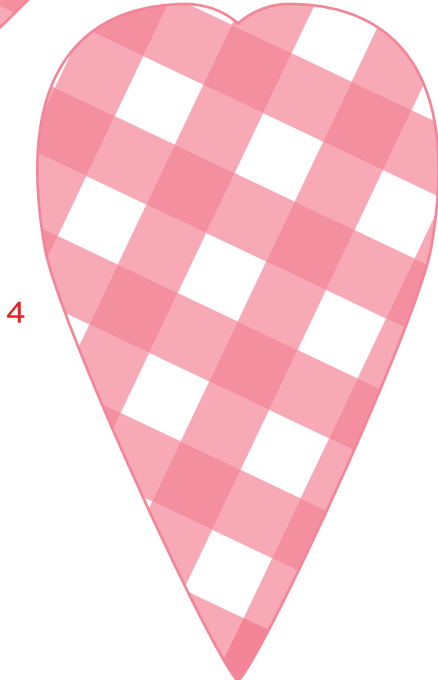
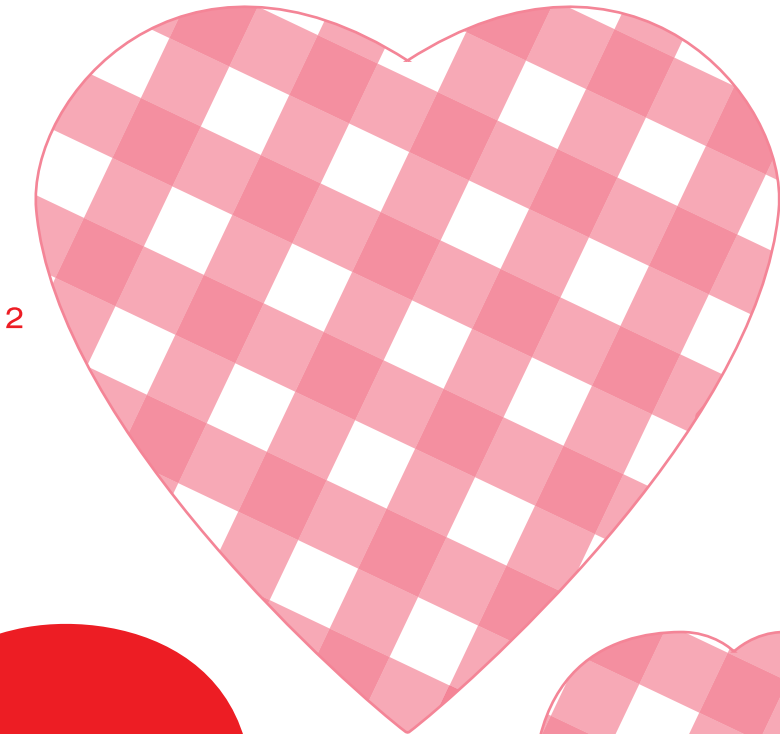
- ④ Cut out the coloured small hearts on page 7 (or black and white on page 8).
- ⑤ Cut the thread into 5 different lengths. Tape one end of each thread to the back of each heart and glue a small heart over the tape for decoration.
- ⑥ Tie the other end of the threads to the coat hanger, spacing them out evenly. Stick a small heart on top for decoration. You can decorate the coat hanger if you like.
- ⑦ Hang your mobile up!

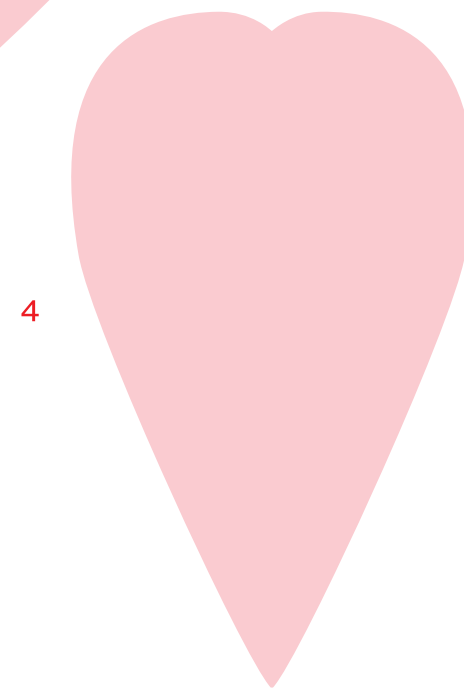
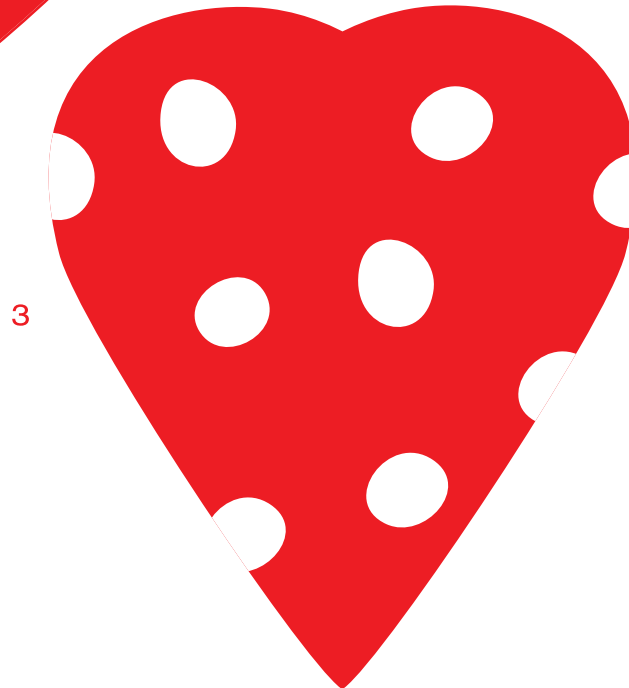
You now have a fantastic

Heart 1. Page 3

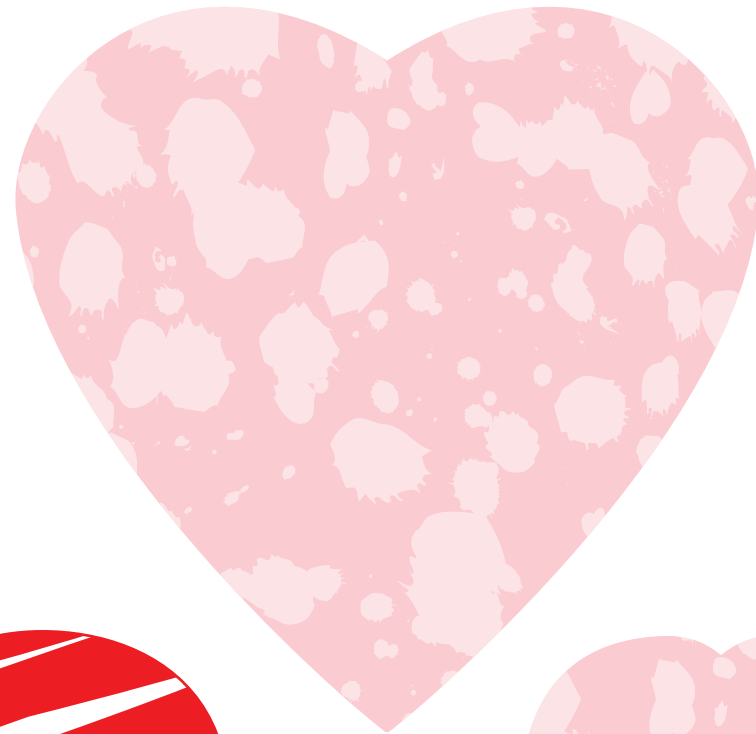
