

Heart Stamp Card

Here's a fun way to make a heart stamp card.

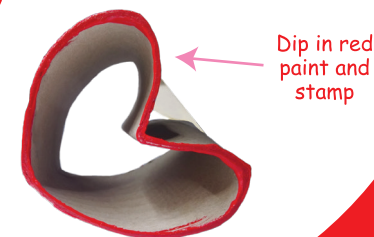
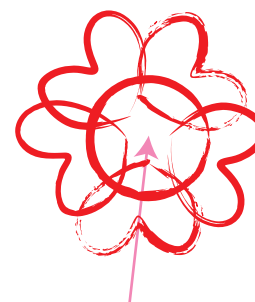
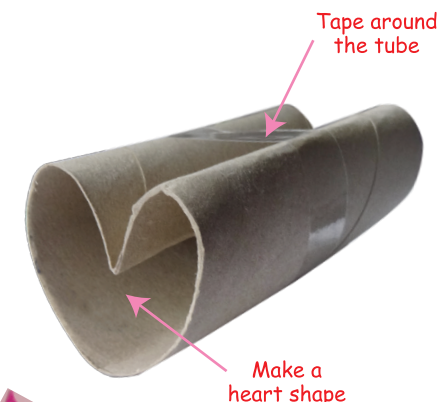
Instructions

- 1 Cut a kitchen roll tube in half. Bend one half of the roll to make a heart shape, then put a piece of tape around the tube to hold its shape.
- 2 Tear up pink tissue paper. Glue the pieces to cover the A4 thin card. They can overlap as shown. Once dry fold in half to make a card shape.
- 3 Put some red paint onto a plate. Dip the round tube in the paint and stamp in the middle of your card. Press down firmly so all the tube touches the card.
- 4 Dip the heart shaped tube in the paint and stamp hearts around the circle you've just made.
- 5 Use red glitter glue to decorate little hearts around your picture.

You now have a fantastic
Heart Stamp Card!

You will need:

1 kitchen roll tube, tape, glue stick, red paint, plate to use as paint palette, A4 thin card, range of light to dark pink tissue paper, red glitter glue.
