

Make a picture frame

Here's a fun way to make picture frame.

Instructions

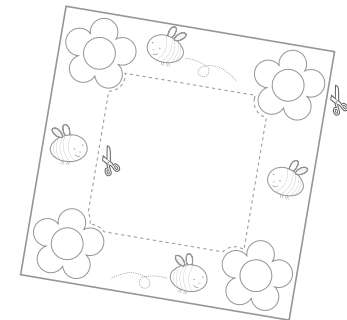
- 1 Print out on to card the frame designs on page 2. Choose which one you would like to use then cut it out, not forgetting to cut the middle out too so your picture shows through.
- 2 You can create your own design with the blank template on page 3, and shapes on page 5. Be as creative as you like. Use pens, pencils to colour in, or tissue paper, even buttons or shells to decorate your frame.
- 3 Once you have finished decorating your frame, stick your picture to the back using tape around the edges. Make sure your picture is big enough to cover the centre hole, but a little bit smaller than the edge of the frame so you have room to stick tape around the edges.
- 4 Next, for the back and the stand, cut out 2 pieces of card 120mm x 120mm, or print on to card the frame back and stand template on page 3 and 4.
- 5 Glue one of the pieces of card to the back of your frame.
- 6 To make the stand, fold the other square in half as shown. Stick with glue or use double sided tape to secure the stand to the back of your frame.

You now have a beautiful picture frame.

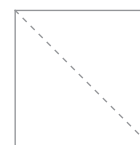


You will need:

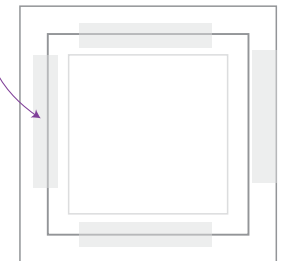
Card, pens or pencils. (You can even use tissue paper, buttons or shells). Scissors, tape, glue, double sided tape. A picture to put in your frame.



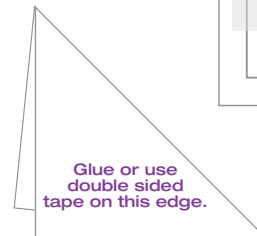
Fold square.



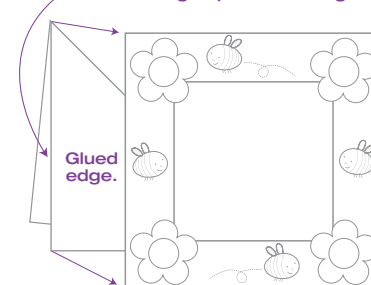
Tape your picture to the back of the frame.



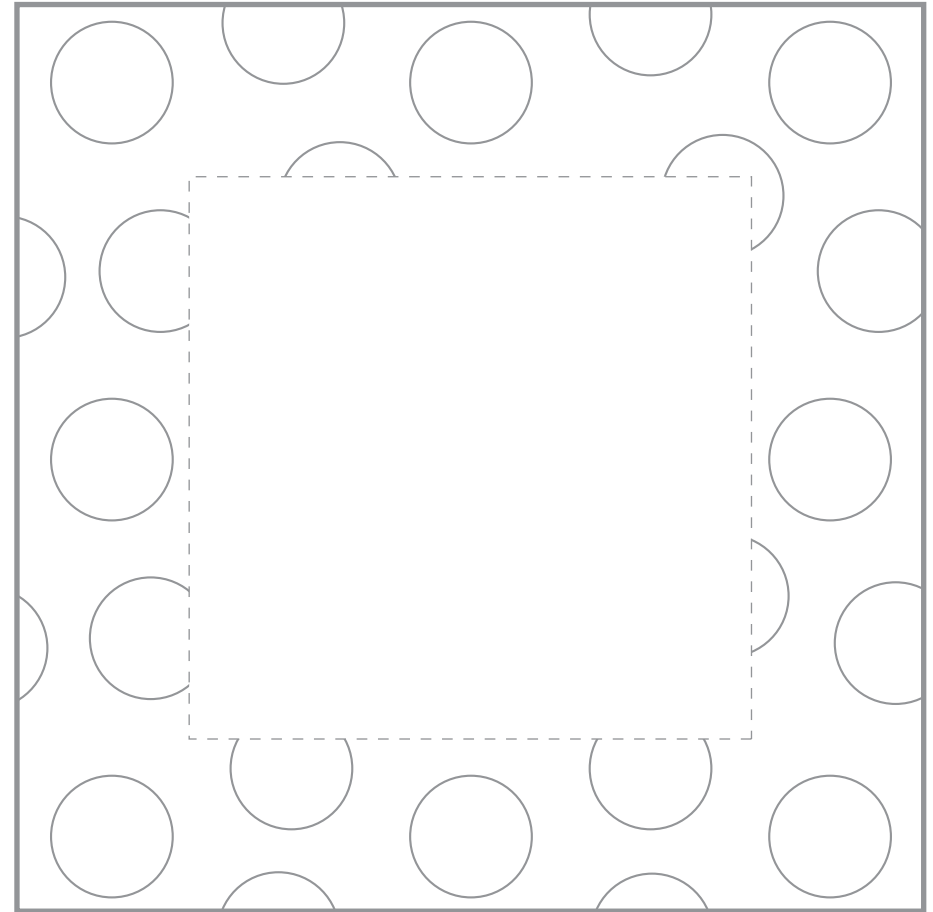
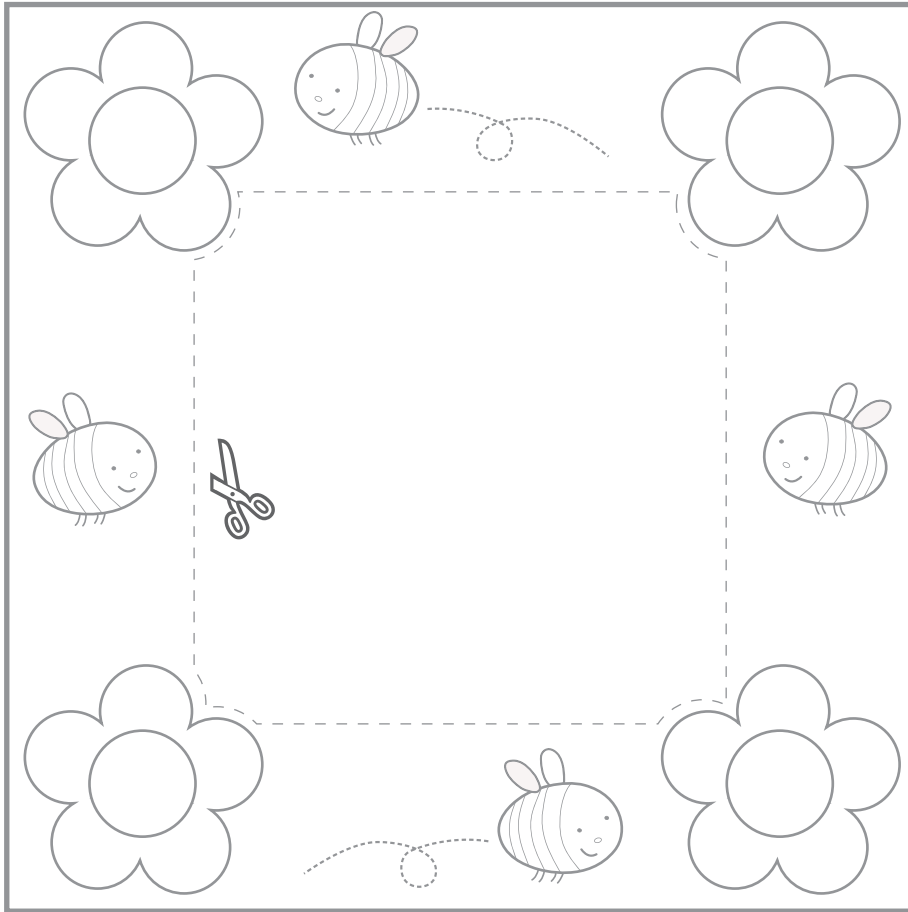
Glue or use double sided tape on this edge.



Line this edge up with the edge of your frame.



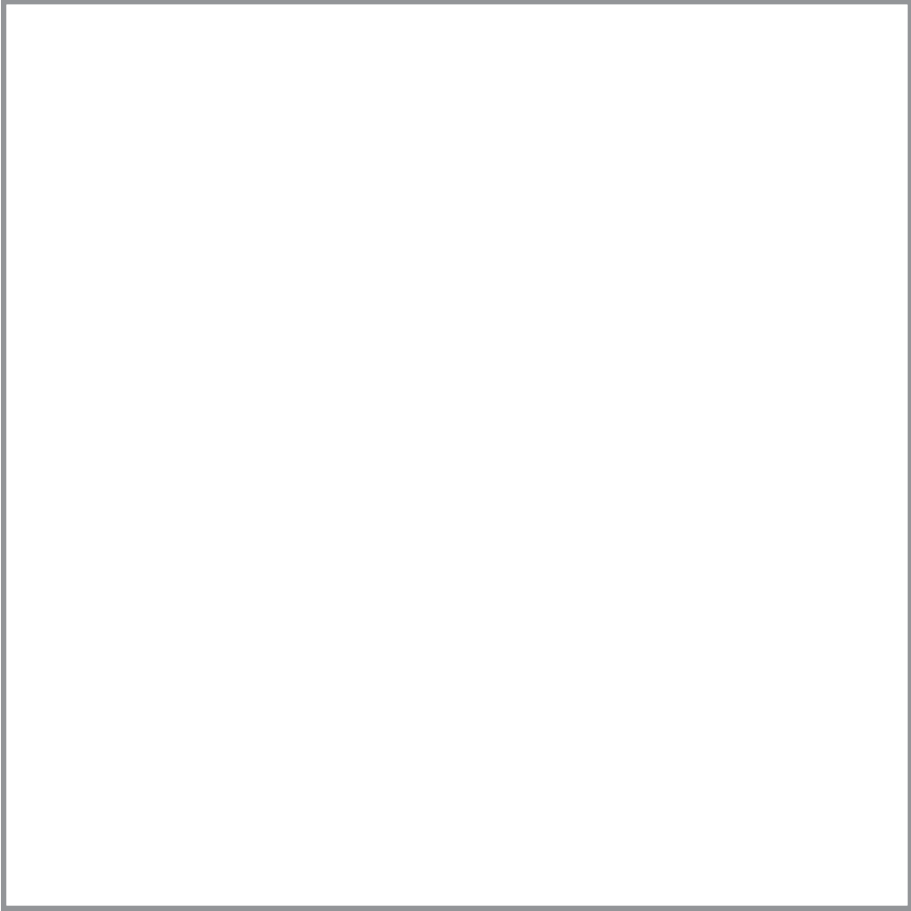

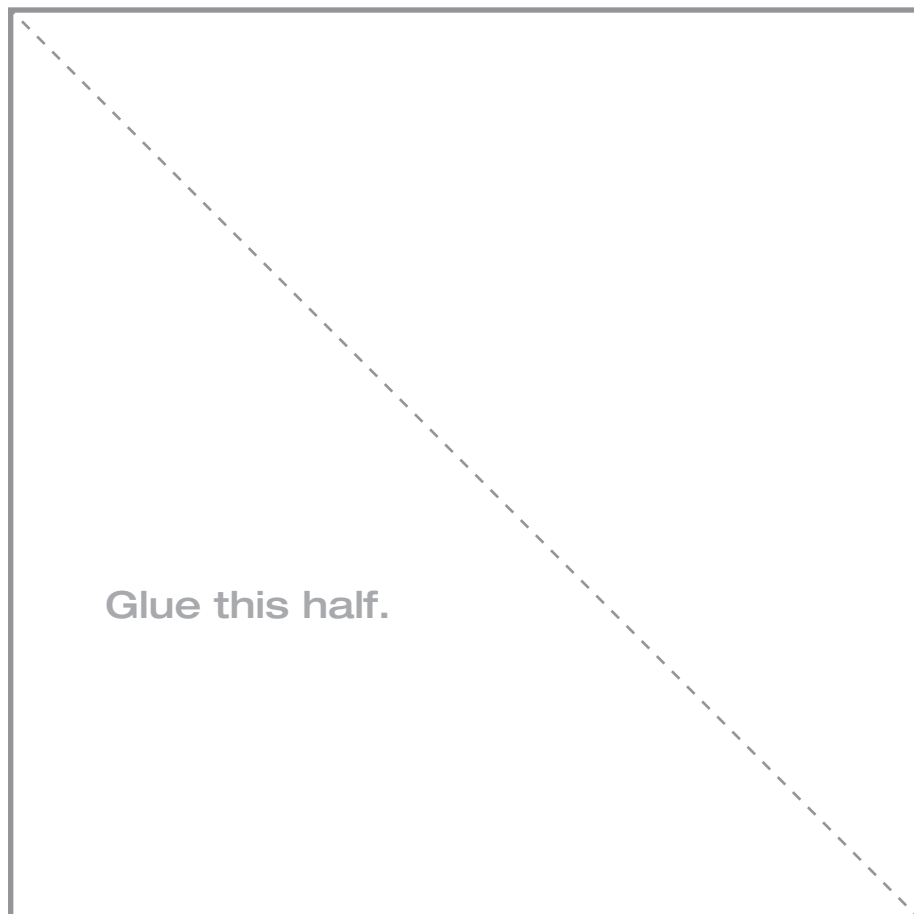
Blank frame.
